**Archival History:** The documents were collected by the Douglas County Historical Society, which was the main historical institution of Douglas County until it disbanded in 1992. The documents were included in the paper-based collections that were donated to the Local History Collection.

**Scope and Content / Abstract:**

Collection consists of memorabilia from the Lewis family of Parker, primarily Emma Lewis, wife of John R. Lewis and their daughter Esther (Estra).

Collection contains a third grade reader from 1890; Yearbook from West High School, Denver, 1900; a school note book with notes on biographies of authors (high school level work); various newspaper clippings (mostly about the Cherry Creek Grange and West Denver High School; and a 1925 High School reunion program (West Denver).

Name of Creator or Compiler of the Collection: Lewis Family

Administrative / Biographical history: Emma C. Lewis, wife of John R. Lewis, was born in England in 1848. She married John R. Lewis in Portland, Maine. They moved to Colorado about 1880. Emma had 4 children, John Henry Lewis, b. 1868 (in 1893, John married Retta Hawkey, she died in 1894); Charles Robert Lewis, b. 1871; Walter Mayo Lewis, b. 1876; and Esther Clara Lewis, b. 1881. Esther married Charles Herzog, 1907, moved to Telluride, had a son Charles Lewis Herzog, 1909. In 1910 they moved to Parker, Colorado. Charles died in 1939. In 1945 Esther married Strafford Tallman. He died in 1967. Esther died in 1945.
