Administrative / Biographical history: The subdivision known as Lone Tree opened in northern Douglas County in 1982. This housing development became the City of Lone Tree, and was incorporated in late 1995. It became a Colorado Home Rule city on May 5, 1998. A major impetus for incorporation were residents' concerns relating to land use, the quality of development along the C-470 corridor, and their desire for greater input over development decisions affecting their future.
