Administrative / Biographical history: Anne Rogers McConnell grew up in Chicago and attended Northwestern University. She married William (Bill) McConnell August 22, 1936. After many years in Chicago, the couple moved to the Denver area in 1964, living first in Littleton, then in Surrey Ridge. Anne owned and operated the Golden Dobbin Restaurant from 1964-1994. While in Douglas County, Anne started the Star lighting Ceremony in Castle Rock and was involved in the formation of the Douglas County Library. She and her husband retired to Arizona, and Anne died in 2003.
